
**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND ADD REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO
MAILBOXES AND DRIVEWAY CULVERTS
IN THE TOWN OF JACKSON**

WHEREAS, the Town of Jackson Town Board has found it necessary to adopt an Ordinance relating to mailboxes and driveway culverts that obstruct or otherwise inhibit roadway maintenance:

Section 1. Mailboxes.

All mailbox installations shall be approved by the Town Building Inspector including their construction and design subject to and in compliance with the United States Postal Services.

No mailbox structure shall be permanent in nature including masonry, brick, stone, iron, cement or similar material within the Town right-of-way. Mailboxes shall be designed to break away and cause limited damage to motor vehicles and snow plows as the same constitutes a safety issue.

Section 2. Driveway Culverts.

No driveway culvert wall shall exceed the Town road height within the Town road right-of-way.

Any existing driveway culvert walls in existence shall be marked for snow plowing purposes in order to avoid damage to snow plows.


